ChurchSuite is a web-based church admin system, which also allows members to manage their details and view messages, rotas and information about church events by logging into "My ChurchSuite".

Get Involved: MyChurchSuite is easy to access and to use, you may already have tried it. The [St Andrew's website](#) now has a quick link to the sign in page for ease of access. If you have not logged in before, you will need an invitation via email, please contact the church office if you would like to be sent one.

Data Privacy: ChurchSuite is a big upgrade for us in terms of keeping personal information safe, and using it responsibly. You can choose what information is stored, and what appears in the directory.

Details for under 18's are processed separately and are not visible.

Please read our privacy notice (available online or on request) if you would like more information. NOTE: Only those who appear in the directory have access to it.

Help at hand: Sarah Stuchbery is available to help members of the 9:30 congregation who would like to check or update their details or who wish to access ChurchSuite directly themselves. For any other questions please contact the church office (details overleaf).

Updating your details: A few things to consider...

- Do fill in as much information as you can, it is so helpful to have a clear picture of our church membership in terms of age, gender etc.
- Your name, address, email and phone number can be visible, but only if you alter your privacy options. Your age or marital status will not appear.
- Please do upload a photo of yourself, it helps us all put more names to faces.
- Be aware that not opting in to receiving emails means we can't easily communicate with you about rotas, and events or activities that you have asked for information about. We don't spam - we're your church family!
