abuse or harm, or other crimes have been com-
mitted, we may be required by law to report this to
the proper legal authorities.**

About Lighthouse Ministry

Lighthouse ministry provides an opportunity to receive prayer if you are experiencing emotional problems, difficulties, issues or distress that prevent you from living in and enjoying the freedom and fullness of life, which Jesus promised.

Past experiences can cause problems in the present if they have led us to believe things about ourselves, the world, or God, which are not true. Jesus created us and has been with us for the whole of our lives (Psalm 139). By His Spirit He can reveal the truth to us and free us to be the people God intended us to be.

In this kind of prayer ministry, Lighthouse team members ask the Holy Spirit to help us to hear Jesus speaking into our situations, to free us to know God's love more fully. Past hurts, some of which may be deep, are brought into the healing light of Jesus. As He reveals truth to us, false beliefs are replaced with truth. The power of the Holy Spirit shows us our true identity in Christ more clearly, leading us into growth and increasing maturity.

Our Team

Everyone whom we train for this ministry has experience in either our Church Ministry Team, or mentoring people, before selection for training. Each of us receives Lighthouse ministry from other team members as often as we need it.

We work in pairs as trained facilitators and love seeing Jesus Christ's changing people's lives.

Receiving Lighthouse Ministry

If you wish to receive Lighthouse ministry do ...

- Meet God in your own quiet times
- Enjoy prayer and Bible reading every day
- Make the most of church services and Home Group meetings
- Ask for prayer from the Prayer Ministry Team at Sunday Services
- Ask a friend or prayer partner to support you through your journey with God

Arranging appointments for you

Once you have had a chat with Alan, he will contact you later to tell you how long you may have to wait for an appointment,. That will depend on the number of times/days of the week when you can meet team members, and on how many team members are available then. Sessions are arranged once times/days are found which suit both you and the two team members.

Your first session may take about two hours, and the team members will discuss with you whether to arrange further sessions.
